

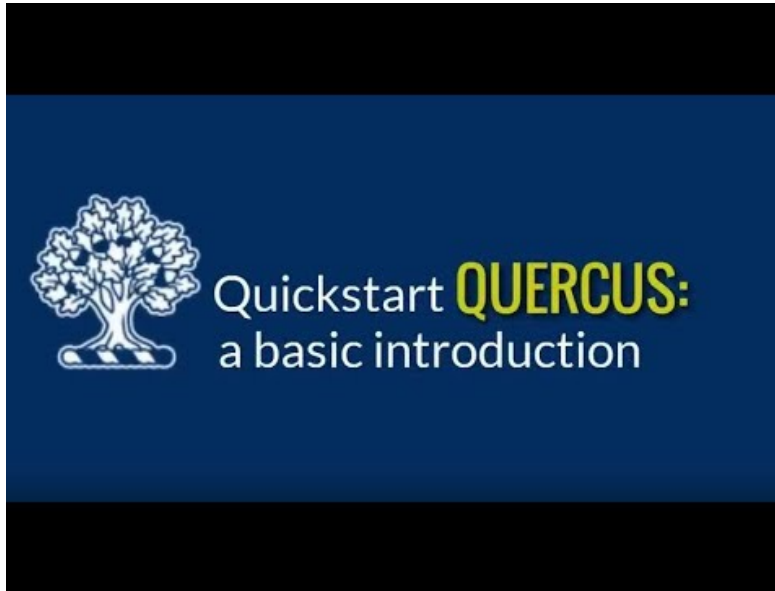

Going back to 1942 and authored by law professors, usually at the top of their field, this is one of the largest sets of legal casebooks in Canadian legal education history, capturing the most significant case law at the time of each casebook's publication.
