You are invited to a “hands-on” Zotero training session, co-organized by the **Faculty of Law’s Research Office** and the law library. Zotero is the most widely used citation management tool for scholars. New College Librarian Jeff Newman will show you how to use this tool to:

- gather, save, and organize bibliographic data (and PDFs!) as you’re doing your research
- create a bibliography as you’re writing your paper
- share your research sources with colleagues

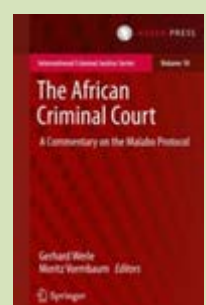
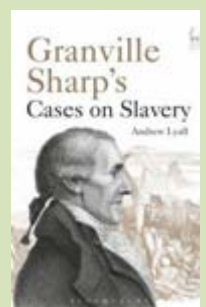
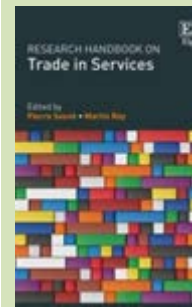
