The Rankings are based on:

- # of times an author has been cited by other articles and cases
- # of times an author's articles have been accessed by other HeinOnline users within a rolling 12-month period
- # of times an author has been cited by articles written in the past 10 yrs.
- # of times an author's articles have been cited by articles written within the past 12-24 months

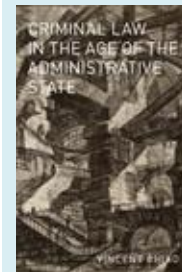
