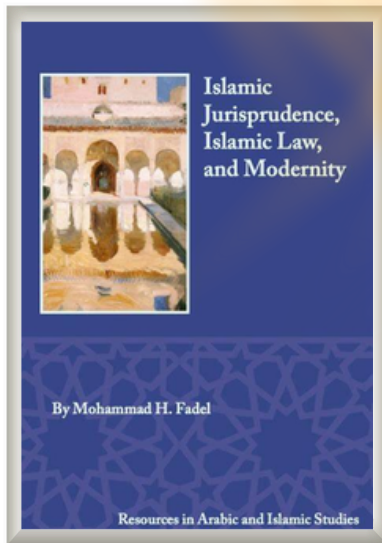

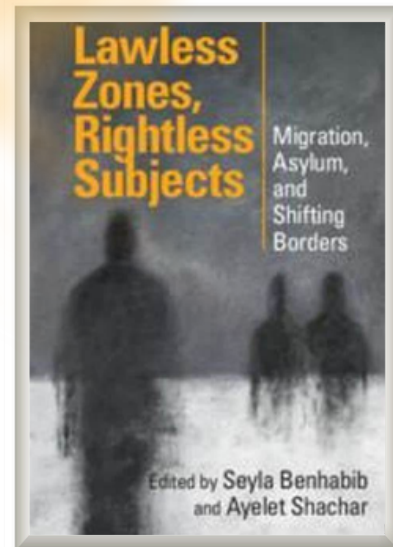

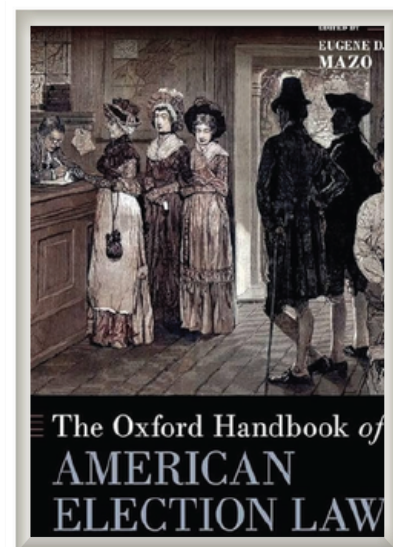

Thomson Reuters is upgrading their password system this month to a more secure system with two-factor authentication features. If you use Westlaw Edge, you will be prompted to migrate your account starting in mid to late March 2025.

## Learn about Altmetric features on HeinOnline

If you're curious what kind of attention your work has received outside of traditional academic scholarship, keep an eye out for Altmetric Attention Scores on HeinOnline.

Like PlumX and other altmetrics tools, Altmetric (owned by the company, Digital Science) draws together mentions or references to journal articles from a variety of online sources like public policy documents, blogs, social media, and more.

HeinOnline recently offered a webinar about the updates to the Altmetric features integrated into their platform. [View the 30-minute webinar on YouTube.](#)

However, not every article in HeinOnline will have an Altmetric page. A "donut badge" containing the attention score will only appear in HeinOnline if the article includes a Digital Object Identifier (DOI) and at least 1 mention/reference from an outside online source. To learn how this works in HeinOnline, check out their [guide to Altmetric.](#)
