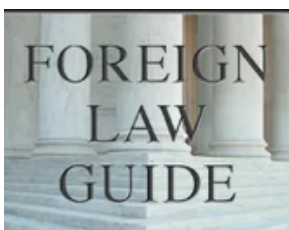


Foreign Law Guide

Approximately 190 jurisdictions are covered and updated by a global team of experts.

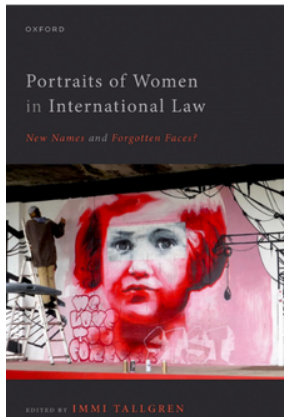
